

# Minutes

Kennedy City Council  
2014 Budget Meeting  
August 19, 2013

**CALL TO ORDER:** Mayor Truedson called the meeting to order at 7:06 P.M. Council Members present were Justin Osowski, Paul Larson, Kevin Hanson and Cindy Urbaniak. Also present were city employees Mary Cooney and Greg Mitziga.

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:** Recited.

**ADDITIONS TO THE AGENDA:** The following three votes were scheduled for this meeting and taken prior to the start of the budget process.

**2013 City Street Repair and Paving.** C. Urbaniak made a motion to accept Minn-Dak Asphalt Inc. Proposal #4767, in the total amount of \$75,000, with work to be completed fall of 2013. K. Hanson seconded. Motion carried.

**City Shop Paint Job.** J. Osowski made a motion to accept the Davis Painting bid of August 15, 2013, in the amount of \$2,575, and any G. Mitziga requested changes capped at a grand total of \$3000, with work to be completed fall of 2013. C. Urbaniak seconded. Motion carried.

**Ball Field Grandstand.** C. Urbaniak made a motion to accept the Beacon Athletic Quote #0238858 and, also, the LMCIT replacement claim in the amount of \$22,000-23,000. K. Hanson seconded. Motion carried.

**BUDGET REVIEW:** A line item review of the budget was completed. K. Hanson made a motion to increase the Donaldson mosquito spraying fee to \$200/time. J. Osowski seconded. Motion carried. K. Hanson made a motion to increase the bus garage stall fees to \$600/year. J. Osowski seconded. Motion carried.

M. Cooney and G. Mitziga left the council chambers for the remainder of the evening, while the wage negotiations portion of the meeting was conducted. The final budget and tax levy will be set once salary negotiations have been completed, which is intended for the September 9, 2013, meeting.

**MEETING ADJOURNED:** The meeting was adjourned at 10:45 p.m. by motion made by P. Larson, seconded by T. Truedson. All in favor, motion carried.
