Cold Storage Pricing Change

The Kennedy Center recently conducted a pricing review on "Cold Storage" facilities within a 45 mile radius. We found that our cold storage prices are more than 50% lower than our closest competitor. To begin to bring our prices more in line with area prices and still remain reasonably priced, the Kennedy City Council voted to raise the Kennedy Center Cold Storage rates to \$300/year. Our cold storage customers will see this increase at the time of their next renewal.
