## Kennedy's Summer Rec Program

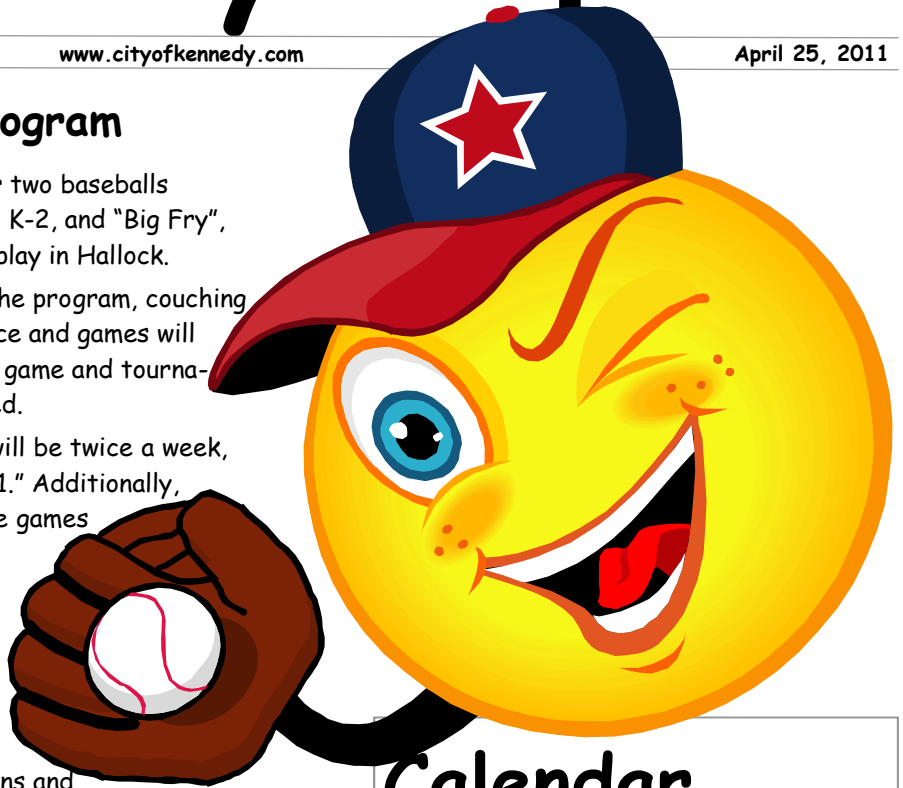
