A Go-Green Update

Since the city's first 2011 public form in June, the city has made it known to Kennedy residents that without increased taxes or private investors, the Kennedy Go-Green Center would not remain open this winter. As reported in the *Kennedy Klips* September issue, the increase of property taxes for the sole purpose of maintaining and operating the Go-Green Center was voted down in August with Kennedy property owners voting 99 NO to 16 YES. Additionally, no investor or group of investors have come forward indicating an interest in operating and financing the Go-Green Center, with a \$1/year lease from the city.

WHAT NEXT? The city has scheduled the winterization of the Go-Green Center. Water pipes will be blown out, bathrooms will be locked, and the building will be secured.

COLD STORAGE will remain available and cold storage tenants will be notified when their new keys are ready. Electricity will not be shut off and cold storage tenants are encouraged to continue air movement in their spaces with the use of fans.

FITNESS CENTER & GYM MEMBERSHIPS will remain a possibility. We currently have walkers avoiding the wind by using the Go-Green Center for walking. Should you be interested, stop in the city office for details. We will contact all gym members once the building has been re-keyed and discuss your options at that time.


