Kennedy's Water & Sewer Rates See 2012 Increase

As recently reported in the *Kittson County Enterprise*, North Kittson Rural Water (NKRW) has increased its water rates by 3% for the year 2012. As NKRW supplies Kennedy's water, the Kennedy City Council voted unanimously at their January 2012 meeting to increase Kennedy 2012 water rates by 3%. The council has also voted to increase the 2012 minimum charge for water by 35¢ per month, and increase 2012 sewer rates by \$1.00 per month.

The Kennedy City Council is committed to keeping the costs of city services as low as possible, while planning for the future. Much of Kennedy's water and sewer system is old and will need incremental replacing beginning this year. For the city to be in a position to meet the needs of Kennedy's aging infrastructure, at a minimum we must keep pace with our expenses *plus* put aside a little for updates. We will inform you of all rate changes and expenses as they happen.
