## Kennedy's Community Garden

The Kennedy Community Garden hired eight of its ten applicants this summer. The understanding is that, as those over 16 are able to get jobs elsewhere, we will limit the garden's employees to under 16 with one exception. The exception being, should the county or any other income source specify funds be spent on youth 16 or older.

The following question has been posed to us many times, "Why do you need to hire so many?" The way we see it is, if a child wants to work, we should go out of our way to make it happen for them. Additionally, we generally limit the hours to between one and two hours per day. And, we encourage the kids to take time off to participate in summer rec, camp, swimming lessons, and all the other summer activities integral to being a kid. So, it isn't so much the number of kids needed as the number of kids interested and willing.
