## Odds & Ends

**KENNEDY CITY COUNCIL VACANCIES.** The Kennedy City Council will have two council seats open for election this year. The term of each council seat is four years.

To register to vote, if you are not a registered voter and wish to vote in this year's election, simply: a) 21 or more days prior to the primary election of August 14, 2012, or prior to the general election of November 6, 2012, go to the Kittson County Auditor's office during regular office hours; b) present valid and current ID; and c) request, complete, and return a voter registration card.

Non-registered eligible voters: An eligible voter who has not registered on the 21st day prior to the election may apply for and receive an absentee ballot by contacting the Kittson County Auditor.

To be eligible as a Kennedy City Council candidate an individual must be: a) eligible to vote; b) at least the age of 21 years on or before January 7, 2013; and c) have been a resident of the City of Kennedy for 30 days prior to November 6, 2012.

To file as a Kennedy City Council candidate, interested eligible individuals must: a) obtain an affidavit of candidacy from the Kennedy City Clerk, during city office hours, between the dates of July 31, 2012, and 5:00 p.m. on August 14, 2012; b) file a signed affidavit of candidacy with the Kennedy City Clerk, during city office hours, between the dates of July 31, 2012, and 5:00 p.m. on August 14, 2012; and c) pay a \$2.00 filing fee.

The City of Kennedy residents vote by mail balloting. You will receive your ballots between 46 and 14 days prior to each the primary and the general election. The Kennedy City Council positions will appear on the general election ballot only.

**DO NOT BURN** at the City of Kennedy burn pile. Again this year, someone started an unauthorized fire at the burn pile, causing numerous issues for the city. We would like to keep this service open to our residents. Please work with us to make this possible.

**TREE STUMP GRINDING.** The city is in the process of scheduling this year's tree stump grinding. Please call the city office at the number below or the city shop at 674-4485 to get you name and the number of tree stumps you want removed added to the list.
