THREE KENNEDY RESIDENTS FILE FOR TWO OPEN COUNCIL SEATS

As previously reported, the Kennedy City Council has two council seats open for election this year, each for a term of four years. As of the 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, August 14, 2012, filing deadline, Affidavits for Candidacy had been filed by Justin Osowski, Jon Pietruszewski, and Cindy Urbaniak.

Kennedy residents vote by mail balloting and will receive ballots between 46 and 14 days prior to the general election. The Kennedy City Council positions will appear on the general election ballot. Vote for two of the three candidates.

Condemnation Update

The City of Kennedy, guided by the city attorney, identified 12 properties within Kennedy's city limits that, per Minnesota state statute, required structural repair or removal. The city notified property owners and offered an incentive to work with the city this year. Four property owners responded affirmatively, resulting in the removal of four structures and the clean-up of four properties during this month of August. The city anticipates four to five property owners will work with them next summer, and the remaining property issues to be resolved early 2014. Watch the *Klips* for updates on this matter.
