RWTR = Water  
WATR = If \$5.00, it's a late fee.  
BWTR = Business Water  
SEWR = Sewer  
NKRW = North Kittson Rural Water. This  
fee is passed on to the city's  
water provider in its entirety.  
SFEE = Service Fee. This fee, in part,  
is sent to the MN Dept. of  
Health. The rest is used for sys-  
tem service & maintenance.  
BLDG = Building Permit  
DOG = Dog License  
MOSQ = Mosquito Spraying  
CONN = Connection Fee  
DISC = Disconnection Fee  
MISC = Miscellaneous Items,  
e.g. spring clean-up pickup,  
load of dirt, or snow removal.



## Use Your Water Wisely



A leaky faucet that drips  
at a rate of one drip per  
second can waste more than  
3,000 gallons of water per  
year. Ten percent of homes

have leaks that waste 90 gallons or more per  
day. Leaky faucets can be corrected by check-  
ing faucet washers and gaskets for wear and  
tear and replacing them if necessary. Fixing  
leaky faucets can save more than 10 percent  
on your water bill.

The EPA estimates that the average water  
user wastes two gallons daily while brushing  
teeth, resulting in an estimated 600 million  
gallons wasted in the US during daily teeth  
brushing alone. To save water, don't run the  
faucet continually while brushing your teeth.

A silent toilet leak can waste several thou-  
sand gallons of water each year. To discover  
if your toilet leaks: (1) lift the lid off your toilet  
tank; (2) place 3-4 drops of food coloring into  
the tank; (3) do not flush or disturb the toilet  
for one to two hours; and, (4) after one to  
two hours, observe the toilet bowl. If the  
color you placed in the tank shows up in the  
bowl, you have a leak. To repair leaks, replace-  
ment valves or kits are available at your local  
hardware store. Also, consider replacing any  
old toilets with more efficient models that  
use 1.6 gallons of water or less per flush.
