
Kennedy's 125th Anniversary Volunteers Are Still Needed

YES, AGAIN...THE KENNEDY BURN PILE IS NOT A GARBAGE DUMP!

The burn pile is for **organic matter only**. **DO NOT** place plastic bags, rubber garden edging, plastic chairs, beer bottles, pop cans or any other non-biodegradable items in the burn pile. The burn pile is for **yard and garden debris only**.

A MOSQUITO SPRAYING FEE of \$5/month has been added to the water bills this month and will continue to appear through September. The fee will only appear once a month, regardless of how many times the City sprays.

DOG LICENSE FEES will be added to the water bill next month. Unlicensed dogs that spend more than thirty days a year at a residence will be charged a license fee regardless of ownership.
