Kennedy Donaldson Senior Center & the Lutheran Social Services Meal Program

Regretfully, Lutheran Social Services (LSS) has informed the K-D Senior Center (the Center) that services are set to be cut, due to devastating budget cuts to LSS in the amounts of \$30,000 this year and \$90,000 next year. LSS is facing tough decisions, none of which will be popular or well received.

How does LSS currently serve the Center? The only services the Center receives from LSS are the noon meal program and meals on wheels. So, these two programs are the only programs that will be affected.

How will the meal program change at the K-D Senior Center? Effective July 1, 2013, LSS will discontinue meal service to the K-D Senior Center. **However**, the Center's board has yet to decide how or if they will provide meals going forward. Once their plan is in place, they will notify the public. Meal participants will be notified later this week.

Is LSS also discontinuing meal service in surrounding communities? One of the difficult decisions LSS had to make was where to cut, with the least amount of impact. And, since Kennedy has the smallest population and smallest number of meal participants, Kennedy's was the LSS meal site that was cut.

Does this mean the Center is closing? **NO.** Not only is the Center **not** closing, but new ideas are in the works that will help sustain and hopefully grow the Center. Some of the ideas include new members, new services, and new events. An official communication will be sent out to the public once the details are finalized *and approved by the board*.

If the Center is not closing, what will the Center offer? The Center will continue to offer meals on some kind of basis, yet to be determined. The Center will continue to offer bingo, card games, foot care and blood pressure checks, and more in the future.

Please continue to support the Center and other establishments and functions in Kennedy, making Kennedy the best little village possible. The *Klips* will continue to keep you posted as information becomes available to us.
