# 2014 City of Kennedy Fee Schedule

At the January 2014 Kennedy City Council meeting, the council voted on and passed the following fee schedule for the year 2014. While the council is committed to keeping all fees as low as possible while best positioning the city to meet its financial obligations, certain fee increases were necessary.

The fees that increased include the (bus) garage stall rental, snow removal, water and sewer. A number of factors weighed into these fee increases. Demand and supply, as well as upcoming needed repairs, factored into the bus garage stall increase. Increased gas, diesel and labor costs contributed to the increase in the snow removal fee. Kennedy's water supplier, North Kittson Rural Water, put into effect a three percent (3%) water rate increase on January 1 of this year, and the city has a \$160,000 water project taking place this summer for which loan payments will have to be made. Both of these factors determined the water rate increase. And, finally, the city's sewer fund has operated at a loss for years, and the council is committed to getting that fund to a break even point. The water and sewer rate increases will be applied beginning on next month's bill, which covers January 16—February 15, 2014.

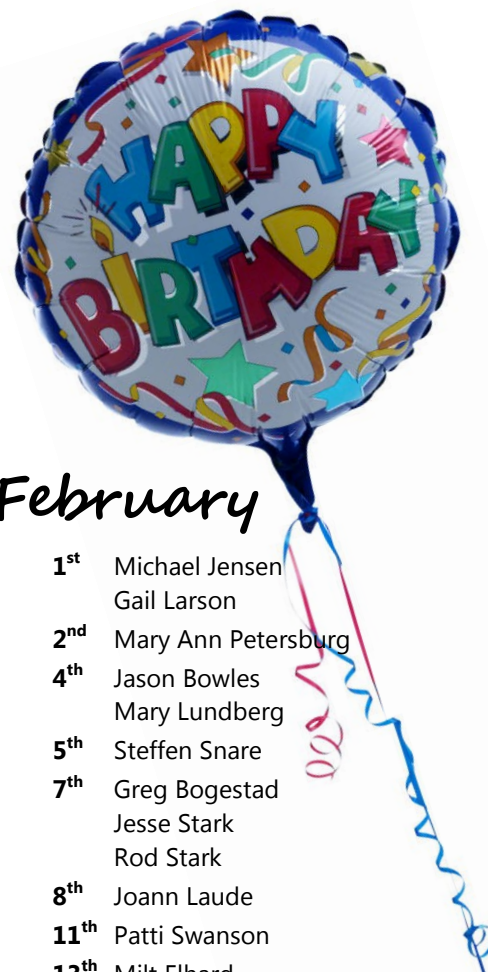
