

The Tri-Valley Opportunity Council is currently seeking Kittson County volunteers for their Foster Grandparent Program.

Foster Grandparent volunteers share their experiences and talents to improve the lives of children in need. Foster Grandparents are placed in non-profit settings such as public/private schools, Head Start programs, developmental achievement centers, non-profit daycare centers and juvenile centers. Volunteer activities take place under the supervision of a teacher or childcare professional.

People 55 years and older receive a tax-free stipend, a daily meal, transportation, transportation allowance, ongoing training and other benefits. The Foster Grandparent Program offers men and women the opportunity to help children develop the skills, confidence and strength to succeed in life. Foster grandparents make their communities stronger by helping children in need.

Home Fire in Kennedy Claims a Life

The Kennedy Fire Department received a fire call for a house fire in Kennedy on Thursday, March 20, 2014, at 12:20 a.m. The house, located on the east side of Kennedy, was owned by Paul Mortenson and was currently home to his daughter, Katrina Mortenson. Mutual aid was received from both the Drayton and the Hallock Fire Departments as they battled the fire alongside of Kennedy's Fire Department. Other emergency services at the scene included the Kittson County Ambulance Service and the Drayton Ambulance Service.

A short time after entering the building, a firefighter carried Katrina Mortenson out of the house and the Kittson Co. Ambulance transported her to Kittson Memorial Hospital in Hallock. Per the *North Star News*, March 27, 2014, edition, "...a doctor at the hospital advised dispatch that the patient, Katrina Mortenson, was deceased upon her arrival at the hospital."

Katrina Mortenson, 40, had only recently moved to Kennedy. She resided in the home with her cat. The cat's deceased body was also recovered from the home.
