THE COULEE WATER PROJECT. The City of Kennedy's water system replacement project stands as follows: (1) engineering contract between the City of Kennedy and KLJ completed; (2) survey and environmental review completed; (3) loan application completed; (4) project plans and specifications **completed**; (5) advertisement for construction bids **in process**; and, (6) begin construction in July 2014. Project completion is projected for August 2013.
