

City Projects Update

DELINQUENT WATER BILLS. In 2011, the City of Kennedy reported a total of \$3,038 in delinquent water bills. At this time, the City of Kennedy is happy and proud to announce that **all** delinquent water bills have been **paid in full!** And, all on-going water bills remain current or within the allowable payment grace period.

PROPERTY CONDEMNATION PROCESS.

Demolition of all condemned properties in Kennedy has taken place. A new review of properties will take place again either later this year or early next year.

THE COULEE WATER PROJECT. The City of Kennedy's water system replacement project stands as follows: (1) engineering contract between the City of Kennedy and KLJ completed; (2) survey and environmental review completed; (3) loan application completed; (4) project plans and specifications completed; (5) advertisement for construction bids **completed**; (6) awarding and signing the construction contract **completed**; (7) construction is scheduled to begin in July 2014. Project completion is projected for August 2013.

Originally, the City qualified for a 30-year loan fixed at one percent (1%) interest to finance the \$160,000 project. However, after engineering and bid letting, the project is now priced at \$128,955 and the City has since qualified for \$103,164 in principal forgiveness (a grant). Therefore, to finance the project balance, only \$25,791 will be borrowed for a 15 year loan term, with a fixed one percent (1%) interest rate.

NWCA OWNER OCCUPIED HOUSING REHAB PROGRAM. Minnesota Deed will review the Kennedy's application sometime this year and the City may then resubmit the application for funding in 2015.

OTHER PROJECTS. Patching the City office roof has been **completed**. Replacing the office windows, replacing the siding on the water tower shed and the bus garage, in addition to repairing the bus garage roof are all projects on hold until funds for these projects are identified and secured.
