## Council Sets Preliminary 2015 Budget

The Kennedy City Council held a special meeting on Monday, October 27, at 7:00 p.m., for the purpose of setting the city's budget for the fiscal year of 2015. The final 2015 property tax levy will be set at the council meeting scheduled for Monday, Nov. 10, and then the final budget will be approved. Some budget line items of interest were preliminarily set as follows:

Re-Roof Bus Garage .....	\$9,000
Propane .....	8,000
Fire Protection .....	6,650
Ball Park .....	5,000
Building Condemnation .....	5,000
Sorenson Park, Basketball Court, Tennis Court, Garden and Play Ground .....	1,100
Kennedy Center .....	500
Clerk's Raise .....	499




