## MORE PUBLIC ART IS COMING TO KENNEDY



The City of Kennedy was awarded two *Arts Legacy Grants* in 2014—the mural painted in the heart of town by area artist Beau Bakken *and* the Kathryn Rynning photo exhibit displayed throughout town, primarily in the café and the Kennedy center—both completed just in time for the city's 125th anniversary celebration.

This year Kennedy has been awarded a third *Arts Legacy Grant* that will sponsor a second public mural. This time the city is working with artist and Kennedy native Connie Nelson and building owner Greg Snare. The mural will be painted on the south wall of Greg Snare's building, facing the north side of the old Petersburg Chevrolet building. Activity on the mural will start sometime in May.

*This activity was funded, in part, by a grant from the Northwest Minnesota Arts Council and the Minnesota arts and cultural heritage funds as appropriated by the Minnesota State Legislature with money from the vote of the people of Minnesota on November 4, 2008.*
