City Projects Update

PROPERTY CONDEMNATION PROCESS.

Demolition of all condemned properties in Kennedy was completed last year. A new review of properties will take place later this year.

KENNEDY'S JUNK ORDINANCE. The Kennedy city council sent letters to city residents in violation of the city's junk ordinance. We should see yards cleaned-up shortly or additional steps will be taken, including fines and assessments to property taxes if necessary.

NWCA OWNER OCCUPIED HOUSING REHAB PROGRAM.

As stated in an earlier *Klips*, Minnesota Deed did approve Kennedy's application for this program. This month program facilitators attended a program implementation workshop. The State of Minnesota is now waiting for the contracts and money from USHUD, which are anticipated within the month. Once the contracts are issued there will be an environmental review, followed by applicant contact and opportunity for additional applicant requests. Watch the *Klips* for information on this project as it becomes available.

CITY OFFICE. Replacing the office windows and repairing and restoring this 110 year old building is still in our sights. We will be contacting a number of residents to join a committee for fund raising. Once we raise approximately \$16,000, we should be able to apply for the rest of the funding from the state. In the meantime, Matt Casper and Carson Thorsteinson have begun to give the office windows and doors a fresh coat of paint. What a huge difference this has made to Kennedy's main street.

2015 ARTS LEGACY FUNDED MURAL. If you haven't driven on the street south of the city office recently, you're missing out. Connie Nelson is making great progress on the city's newest mural.

CITY MAINTENANCE. Alleys throughout town have been graveled and newly painted curbs and cross-walks are coming soon.

OTHER PROJECTS. Replacing the siding on the water tower shed and the bus garage, in addition to repairing the bus garage roof are all projects on hold until funds for these projects are identified and secured.
