

## NWCA OWNER OCCUPIED HOUSING REHAB PROGRAM UPDATE

As reported in the February 2015 issue of the *Klips*, 19 homeowners in the city of Kennedy completed participation interest statements for the NWCA Owner Occupied Housing Rehab program. In June we reported that applicant contact and opportunity for additional applicant requests were pending. And, after speaking with our program contact today, we were informed **the pre-application forms were mailed out to the 19 interested home-owners today!** Please, watch your mail and complete and return the required paperwork in a timely manner.

Once homeowner applications are processed, income will be verified. Hopefully, we will see some funds awarded yet this year.

This project is a great opportunity for qualified home-owners. But, as you may be aware, government programs often move along slowly and that appears to be the case here. However, the money will be made available to qualified homeowners once all of the hurdles have been cleared. So, stay tuned for further developments and watch your mail.

## The Kennedy City Council unanimously approves "Tobacco-Free Parks Policy"

At the July 13, 2015, regularly scheduled city council meeting the Kennedy city council unanimously approved the following "Tobacco-Free Parks Policy" with the intent of regulating the use of tobacco products and electronic cigarettes at the city's parks—Sorenson Park and LC Deere Ball Field.

**BACKGROUND.** Tobacco is a proven health and safety hazard for users and non-users alike. Exposure to second-hand smoke has been linked to a wide range of serious and life threatening health problems including heart disease, cancer, asthma and other respiratory problems. Products consumed in public spaces are often discarded on the ground, creating environmental blight and toxic consequences if consumed by children.

Electronic cigarettes and related devices resemble and purposefully mimic the act of smoking. They produce a vapor of undetermined and potentially harmful substances. Their use in locations where smoking is prohibited creates concern and confusion, making enforcement more difficult.

**POLICY.** The use of tobacco products and electronic cigarettes is prohibited at Sorenson Park and at LC Deere Ball Field, effectively immediately. Signage has been posted to notify park users of this policy. Individuals acting in violation of this policy may be asked to leave the city's parks.
